Recently recognized by Israeli authorities as an official non-profit in Israel, we are dedicated to creating innovative and sustainable solutions to address the evolving needs of psychedelic assisted therapy and mental health in Israel.

Our aim is to promote an environment where psychedelic therapy is widely recognized and accessible to all individuals in a fair and equitable manner.

We plan to achieve this through research and education, policy work and an advisory referral service, all serving to ease and increase access to legal therapeutic possibilities
